both of you make a claim then the Tax Credit Office will decide after contacting you both).

Working Tax Credit – You can claim working tax credit if • are aged 25 or over and work at least 30 hours • you are aged 16 or over and work at least 16 hours a week and qualify for a disability element of Working Tax • you or your partner are aged over 50 and work at least 16 hours a week and are returning to work after claiming qualifying out-of-work benefits. • If you are aged 16 or over and are responsible for a child or young person and you work at least 16 hours a week.

Childcare Costs - If you work for at least 16 hours per week and pay for childcare you may be able to get tax credit to help towards the childcare costs. You may still qualify if you worked 16 hours or more before going on maternity, paternity, adoption or sick leave. If you are away from work to care for a child you can't get childcare costs for that child. Costs are paid up to the week of 1 September following the child's 15th birthday, or 16th birthday if the child is disabled. The childcare must be registered or accredited, or provided by a school; such as a breakfast or after school club.

Making a Claim - To Claim Tax Credit you have to fill in a claim form (you will get a set of notes with your claim form that should help you to fill it in). You can order a tax credits claim pack from the Tax Credit Helpline on 0845 300 3900. If you need any help completing the form you can • call the Tax Credit Helpline • make an appointment with Community Law Service (*formerly known as Welfare Rights*) • or, if you claim other benefits, such as Income Support or Jobseekers Allowance, your Jobcentre Plus will help you with your tax credits claim form. Remember - if you live with someone as a couple you must make a joint tax credits claim as you can not claim as a single person. You will have to put down information about both of you on the claim form and you will share responsibility for making sure that this information is correct. When you make a claim you'll need to give HMRC details of your income for the last tax year (a tax year runs from 6 April one year to 5 April the next).
