Relationship and Sex Education coverage:

Year 3 – Growing and changing

In this unit your child will think more about their bodies' capabilities and uniqueness as we endeavour to develop the children's positive body image. They will learn:

- Identify different types of relationships and recognise who they have positive healthy relationships with
- They will understand what is meant by the term body space (or personal space)
- Identify when it is appropriate or inappropriate to allow someone into their body space and rehearse strategies for when someone is inappropriately in their body space
- How to ask for help if a secret made them feel uncomfortable or unsafe
- That babies come from the joining of an egg and sperm and that for girls, periods are a normal part of puberty
- Concepts of basic first-aid, for example dealing with common injuries, including head injuries and making an emergency call to 999
