Asymptomatic testing information for parents and adults in households with children at school or college

You may be aware that NHS Test and Trace announced earlier this week, that all adults in households with school and college age children without symptoms can now access regular rapid coronavirus (COVID-19) testing.

Tests can be obtained:

- through your employer, if they offer testing to employees
- by collecting a home test kit from a local test site – anyone aged 18 or over can collect 2 packs of 7 tests (please note, school cannot provide home testing kits)
- by ordering a home test kit online – please do not order online if you can access testing through other routes, this frees-up home delivery for those who need it most
